Matters Arising

376/04/10 – There were no matters arising

Clerks Report

377/04/10 – The Clerk reported that Chorley Council could not do anything regarding the Cat faeces on the Playground but suggested that a repellent available from garden/DIY stores may help – It was agreed to try and use some solutions to alleviate the problem

378/04/10 – Chorley Council have stated that the repair to the Millbrook Green will be dealt with As soon as possible

379/04/10 – The Clerk reported that the Tree on Victoria Street had been felled and stump grinding was completed on the 19th March

381/04/10 – The candidates in the forthcoming Elections asked to meet with the Parish Council.
